DOWNTOWN WINNIPEG ATTRACTIONS

The Forks National Historic Site (theforks.com)

A historic meeting place for over 6000 years located at the junction of the Assiniboine and Red Rivers. Attractions include The Forks Market, the Assiniboine Riverwalk, The Plaza at The Forks skatepark, park areas, shops, and restaurants. 10 minute walking distance.

Exchange District (exchangedistrict.org)

The centre of commerce and culture in Winnipeg at the turn of the 20th century. Attractions include theatres, terra cotta and cut-stone architecture, shops, and restaurants. 15 minute walking distance.

Manitoba Legislative Building (gov.mb.ca/mit/legtour/legbld.html)

Beaux-Arts Classical architecture featuring Manitoba Tyndall limestone and the Golden Boy statue. 12 minute walking distance.

Winnipeg Art Gallery (wag.ca)

Canada's first civic art gallery, currently celebrating its 100th anniversary. Includes works by Canadians Lawren S. Harris and Emily Carr as well as international works and Inuit art. 15 minute walking distance.

University of Winnipeg (uwinnipeg.ca)

One of Winnipeg's major universities, dating back over 130 years. Features the new Richardson College for the Environment and Science Complex. 15 minute walking distance.

The Manitoba Museum (manitobamuseum.ca)

Renowned for its combined human and natural heritage themes. Offers a range of exhibits showcasing natural sciences and history of the prairies and Canada. 20 minute walking distance.

The Winnipeg Fringe Festival (winnipegfringe.com)

Running from July 17-28, this theatre is the second-largest of its kind in North America, hosting over 150 theatre companies that each have complete artistic freedom over their show. Venues range 15-20 minute walking distance.
