ASBESTOS NOTIFICATION AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT

NOTIFICATION BY THE UNIVERSITY OF MANITOBA:
 The University of Manitoba has identified the presence of various friable and non-friable asbestos-containing materials as being present throughout many of the buildings, tunnels and grounds owned, leased and/or otherwise occupied by the University. For a complete listing of any asbestos-containing or suspect asbestos material known to be present refer to the most recent version of the Asbestos Survey Report maintained on file by the Environmental Health and Safety Office (Pearl Novotny, 474-6633) and the Physical Plant Department (Mary Dunetz, 474-8913).

Every effort has been made to identify known asbestos containing materials within the areas of the proposed work and where in direct conflict or where posing a hazard, to remove it by proper controlled means before construction. As a precautionary measure, where material is encountered by trades and contractors that is suspect or suspicious, the Trades/Contractor/Subcontractor is to contact the University Project Coordinator who will have samples taken and tested to confirm its composition.

Mb. Reg. 53-88 (Workplace Health Hazard Regulation), Mb. Reg. 100-88R (Fibrosis and Silicosis Regulation) and associated Guidelines apply to all maintenance and renovation work that may disturb asbestos or suspect asbestos-containing materials in the Workplace. Such regulations and guidelines state that any disturbance of asbestos-containing materials may only be performed by workers or by an outside contractor who have first received the required training in asbestos-related precautions.

WORKING WITH ASBESTOS CAN BE DANGEROUS.
 INHALING ASBESTOS FIBERS CAN CAUSE VARIOUS TYPES OF LUNG DISEASE INCLUDING CANCER. SMOKING INCREASES THE RISK OF LUNG CANCER FROM ASBESTOS EXPOSURE.

In undertaking the work of this project, we the trade or contractor agree to perform our work in such a manner so as NOT to disturb any asbestos-containing materials without:

1. reviewing the most recent Asbestos Survey Report; and
2. giving notice to the appropriate supervisor, individual manager and/or project coordinator at the University that known or suspected asbestos-containing material(s) will be disturbed, or
3. halting work and giving notice to the appropriate individual manager and/or project coordinator at the University when unforeseen asbestos-containing materials are uncovered during the provisions of services/materials to the University.
